In the AISSE [Class X], out of 57 students 55 passed with distinction and 6 students got full A1 Grades. Aparna. The A1 holders, subject toppers were awarded merit certificates and trophies by our honorable MLA of Mannarkkad, Adv. N Shamsudheen. This year, we have 71 students appearing for class X Board Exams. SAHODAYA FEST

I proudly announce the winners of Sahodaya Dance Fest which was conducted at Shornur Carmel School on October 11,12,13. Sanjana S of our school secured Ist place in district and state kalotsav. . For the group item One Act Play, Group Dance – UP and HS section won 1st prize in District Sahodhaya. For the first time in the history of St Dominic school, we could get the overall first in the group item.

Our students bagged a couple of prizes in the district Sahodhaya Literary Meet conducted at Bharathamatha CMI Public school Palakkad. In Versification English Devika NV won Ist prize. Our school band bagged 3rd place in state kalotsav conduted by CMI Public school Vazhakkulam, Ernakulam. Our students also participated in English Fest and secured A Grade.

TRAINING PROGRAMMES FOR STUDENTS:

Leadership Training and Personality Development:

St. Dominic's School is committed to groom the leaders of tomorrow. The development of personality and skills, especially leadership skills, has become a necessary factor in today's competitive world. Taking this into consideration, the school offers leadership training camps and personality development workshops, conducted by eminent trainers.

English Language Training:

Today, the importance of English cannot be denied nor ignored. In order to help students and teachers improve their standard of English, expert trainers are available on campus throughout the day. Activities like debate, quiz, spelling bee, anchoring and public speaking and many more are used in training the students.

SKILLS TRAINING:

a. **The class magazine**: Apart from promoting the creative and literary skills of the students, the class magazine paves way for improving interpersonal and leadership skills , competitive mind and team spirit among the students .

b. **Theme Based Notice Boards** – Each club and house is provided with a notice board, to display their knowledge and skills. Articles on the theme of the week, drawings and personalities for the month were put up. Creating such articles motivates them to draw inspiration from these themes and personalities on how to succeed and live a value based life.

c. **Remedial classes-** Special care was given to the low achievers in order to improve their academic quality. We keep morning and evening classes for weaker students.

GUIDANCE & COUNSELLING : The school not only provides the necessary initial support to the troubled students but also organizes personality development programmes and career guidance seminars for students and orientation programmes for teachers and parents. To ensure that our students are well equipped with knowledge to face any challenge, we have focused sessions on special topics including Disaster Management, Basic Life Support, Health and Hygiene, Career Counseling, Leadership Skills, Career Planning and Development

SEMINAR FOR TEACHERS

A one week orientation programme in the month of May, we provide for all teachers to energise teachers in their teaching field. And other Orientation programs and workshops for teachers are an integral part of every academic year. On November 2nd, teachers had a seminar on Teachers Enrichment and Communicative English. The class was taken by Mr. Hari Chandran, Master Trainer and Resource Person of Oxford University.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities classes are held on Tuesdays. Children are given special coaching in Instrumental Music (Keyboard, Guitar, Violin), Dance (classical & Western) Karate, Yoga, Roller Skating, Art and Archery. Gagan of Class VII is one of the Guinness Award Winner for doing Roller skating for 24 hours continuously.

VALUE BASED EDUCATION

Apart from regular subjects, we impart value based and life oriented education, which help students stand the test of time. We have various programmes for this purpose.

1. Moral and Religious Instruction

In addition to the weekly value education class , retreats and spiritual renewal programmes by renowned preachers were conducted for students and teachers.

2. Social Service & Community Reach out Programs

School opened its doors to the flood hit people of Nilambur. We collected a sum of Rs . 2 lakhs to help the victims of flood and for other social welfare scheme. Along with the students and faculties spent time with the people of Kavalappara.
